ARISE RETREAT STANDARDS & DRESS CODE

The following standards will be observed at the retreat.

- All registered students must stay for the entire duration of the retreat. For exceptions you must receive permission from ARISE by contacting info@ariseyouth.org July 23, 2010.
- All registered students must stay on the retreat site at all times. There can be **no use of personal vehicles** during the time of the retreat.
- We ask non-registered youth students and post-high school individuals not to be on retreat site for the duration of the retreat. ARISE directors reserve the right to ask any such individuals to leave at their discretion.
- Students found with illegal substances, or engaged in violent or sexual misbehaviors, upon investigation, will have their parent(s) / guardian contacted, and be asked to leave retreat premises immediately.

The ARISE Retreat Coordinators thought it best to implement a dress code in order to ensure the most conducive environment for worship and fellowship. Let's try to create a place where we can focus on loving God and others, without being too distracted by what people are wearing (reality check – it will still happen, but let's keep the distractions to a minimum). **Counselors and retreat coordinators have the right to ask you to change if you do not comply.** In matters of opinion, the judgment of the retreat coordinators shall prevail. Let's seek to promote an environment where purity is upheld.

The following dress code will be observed at the retreat.

- **Shirts and tops** must completely cover the abdomen and back. No midriff, halters, tube-tops, tank tops, low-cut shirts or backless shirts will be allowed. No showing of underwear, please.
- **Shorts** must be beyond fingertip length (middle or ring fingers).
- **Jeans (low-rise)/pants/shorts**, you must not be showing any underwear (i.e. boxers, panties) or your mid-section. Ladies: please be careful when sitting in chairs or on the floor because you might be exposing too much skin.
- Proper **footwear** is required and must be appropriate for indoor and outdoor activity. You may be doing a lot of walking and other strenuous activities. Remember: health and safety above fashion, please. This is a *camp/retreat*.

Common Sense Stuff:

- Clothing and accessories such as backpacks, patches, jewelry, and notebooks must not display (1) racial or ethnic slurs/symbols, (2) gang affiliations, (3) vulgar, subversive, or sexually suggestive language or images; nor, should they promote products which students may not legally buy; such as alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.
